## **Canada Research Excellence Fund (CFREF)**

- Expression of interest statement (500 words) has been submitted
- Further work in this regard will require collaboration and outreach to all known and potential collaborators (locally and worldwide)
- More work forthcoming if expression of interest statement is well received

#### MHRC Graduate School/Summer Course

- Option 1 (graduate school) is favoured over an undergraduate-aimed program
- Utilize demonstrations and education seminars; not meant to "train" students on procedure, but rather introduce them to new techniques/methods
- <u>not</u> directed towards students with medical school in mind, but geared towards current/future researchers
- goal is for an inaugural course in summer 2016

## **E-Learning MHRC course**

- Can this be tied into the MHRC graduate summer school?
- How will this be integrated into current curriculum?
- Appears there is a bigger market at the undergraduate level rather than as a graduate course; could this be introduced as part of a continuing education program?
  - o Enrolment form an undergraduate pool may also be higher
  - o Time commitment for an online course is <u>substantial</u>; need to keep this in mind
